As a parent/guardian of the above child I agree:

- To my child taking part in coaching, training and matches as directed by the Coach/Managers appointed by Dorset Badminton.
- To inform the coach of any health issues or injuries that could occur, or that might affect the players conduct during any session.
- That the supervising coach may give consent to any medical treatment, which in the opinion of any first aider or qualified practitioner is deemed necessary.
- That in the event of an accident the coach supervising the session will contact me at the earliest opportunity.
- That as and when necessary the coach may transport my child to or from training sessions or to matches (those requiring overnight stay will be dealt with separately).
- To the use of photos of my child in reports of tournaments or matches, for the local press or the DBA website.
- To complete by the 30th September each year a sheet of commitments relating to matches, so that the coach/managers can plan their team selections and so you can plan your child's tournament schedule if necessary.

Also, all training fees to be paid by 30th September at the latest (due date is 1st August). Any unpaid fees by 15th October, will result in the player being banned from training until all fees are paid.

- That the coach manager's decision regarding selection is final. Their selections may be made for a variety of reasons and might not necessarily include the best players from time to time. They need to extend match play to as many as possible in each age group. Players competing up an age group will only be allowed to do so providing both age group managers agree.
- That I will not interfere with play, or encroach on to the court during practices or matches even if finished.
- That I will respect the opposition in matches or tournaments.
- That any major dispute is firstly dealt with by the Head Coach and if not satisfied by the Coaching Committee and then on to the Parent Representative who sits on DBA Committee.
